

Open Land Registry Data

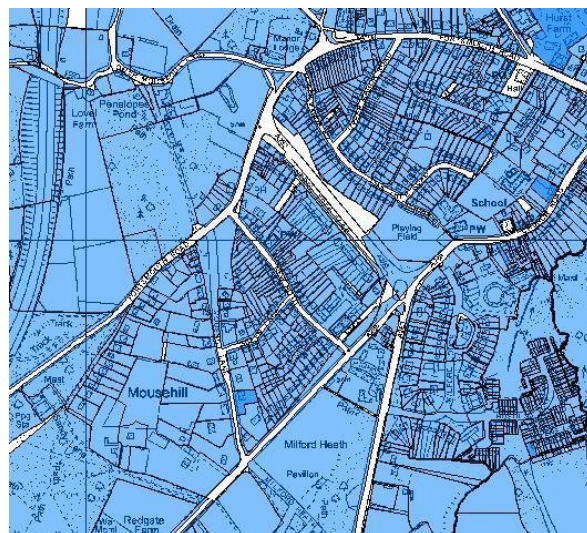
Government Organisations are opening up the access to their data. Land Registry is the latest to open its doors.

Now it is possible for you to get the map data showing all areas of registered land, with the areas identified with an Inspire ID, linking you to the documentation for the title number.

Please ask Pear Technology for any further information about obtaining the data for your maps.

What It Offers

- » With the data in PT-Mapper you are able to see all registered and unregistered land. This can be overlaid onto your current maps.
- » Each 'polygon' or boundary comes with an identifying number. When selected the Inspire ID is presented which can be copied into the Land Registry website through the link [here](#).
- » Through the Land Registry website you can download the documentation related to the registered land.



Accessing the data

- » This data is available through Pear Technology. Using an area of your defining the data can be cut and returned to you.
- » Any existing map object can be used from PT-Mapper, such as the estate boundary or frame to cut the data.
- » If you know the area you are interested in you are able to draw an area in Google Earth which can be forwarded onto Pear Technology to quote and cut the data. To find out how to draw and share areas in Google Earth please find the associated document [here](#).
